The Jerome Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on January 22, 2019 at 8:04 p.m. following a public hearing. Board Chairman Joe Craft called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Ronald Rhodes, Joe Craft and C.J. Lovejoy answered the roll call. Also in attendance were Robert Caldwell (Fiscal Officer), Mark Spagnuolo (Zoning Inspector), Doug Stewart (Fire Chief) and members of the public.

Mr. Craft presented the agenda which was reviewed, modified as necessary and approved.

Robert Caldwell, Fiscal Officer, provided the Board with updated financial reports (receipt account status, appropriation status and fund status). Mr. Caldwell presented the pending warrants as detailed in the "Pending Warrant Report," for payment. The Fiscal Officer certified that there were sufficient funds to pay the bills. It was moved by Ron Rhodes and seconded by C.J. Lovejoy that the Jerome Township Board of Trustees adopt the following resolution:

The Jerome Township Board of Trustees approve warrants 39829 through 39911 and 98096 through 99009 for payment.

Mr. Caldwell presented the Board with a report from the Ohio Department of Transportation for the 2018 Township Highway System Mileage Certification indicating that the Township had 26.082 miles of road, up from 23.174.

Mr. Caldwell indicated that the Township was in receipt of the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) 2019 membership dues invoice in the amount of \$3,938.05 and asked to Board if they wished to continue this membership. It was moved by Ron Rhodes and seconded by Joe Craft that the Jerome Township Board of Trustees adopt the following resolution:

The Jerome Township Board of Trustees renew the 2019 membership dues with the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC).

Public Participation

Jeanette Harrington asked the Board how are they going to residents near the commercial areas from large buildings in light of the recent change to the zoning resolution. Mr. Craft empathized stating he can see her reason for concern. The Board indication at steps are being taken to look at an overlay plan. Ms. Harrington expressed her concern over the lack of long term vision.

Jeff Kuzma stated that over his years with the Township that the zoning has worked for the most part and issues will be encountered in any area growing at the rate Jerome Township is growing.

Megan Sloat stated that she realizes that this area is the fastest growing area and that she knows it will not remain farmland. However, she stated there needs to be a structural transition plan from commercial areas to residential areas. Building sizes need to be limited to a size that residents can be comfortable with and not massive. In addition she encouraged the Board to involve residents in the comprehensive plan update. Mr. Craft assured those in attendance that the Board will look at the various areas and determine what works and what does not work.

Chris Schmeck, Union County Commissioner, was in attendance to show here continued willingness to work with the Township. As part of that relationship, Mr. Rhodes recommended that the Board approve the expenditure of \$25,000 to the Union County Sheriff's Office with the possibility that it be used to acquire an additional canine. The Board members were all in agreement.
