The Jerome Township Board of Trustees met in regular session on November 19, 2019 at 7:12 p.m. Board Chairman Joe Craft called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Ronald Rhodes, Joe Craft and C.J. Lovejoy answered the roll call. Also in attendance were Robert Caldwell (Fiscal Officer), Eric Snowden (Zoning Coordinator/Inspector), Doug Stewart (Fire Chief/Director of Departments), Peter Griggs (Brosius, Johnson and Griggs), Eric Phillips (Union County) and members of the public.

Mr. Craft presented the agenda which was reviewed, modified as necessary and approved.

Eric Phillips presented to the Board a proposed project that has been five years in development. The project is the construction of a 250,000 square foot facility by Amazon Data Services for a data services facility on approximately 300 acres at the northwest corner of Industrial Parkway and Warner Road. He presented the Board with an enterprise zone agreement which will allow for a ten year, one hundred percent tax abatement. He reported that currently the existing farm land is producing \$5,494 annually in taxes of which the Township receives \$1,425. He stated he is seeking the consent of the Board of Trustees for the agreement. In addition to the enterprise zone agreement he also presented a donation agreement associated with the project which would provide monies to those parties of the agreement in lieu of taxes in the amount of four million dollars over the course of ten years. The amount to be received by Jerome Township would be \$500,000 over the ten year period or \$50,000 per year. He added that this would be the first joint economic development district (JEDD) project for the newly created JEDD within Jerome Township and would provide income tax revenue to the parties of the JEDD.

Union County Commissioner Steve Stolte and City of Marysville Major J.R. Roush spoke in support of the agreements indicating monies will be invested back into infrastructure.

Mr. Rhodes asked when the first payment would be due and Eric Phillips indicated it would be 2021.

Barry Adler expressed support of the project, however voiced concerns surrounding the transparency of the agreement. He said he felt residents did not have ample opportunities to voice their opinion throughout the process and hoped they would be more involved as it progresses.
